



## ChinaCom2007 Student Participation and Travel Grants

In order to encourage students presenting at **ChinaCom 2007**, **20 Student Participation Grants** and **10 Student Travel Grants** will be provided. Requests for the grants should be submitted to [info.chinacom@create-net.org](mailto:info.chinacom@create-net.org) by **June 20, 2007**, and the grant award will be informed by **July 5, 2007**. **Student Participation Grants** will be offered at the time of registration, while **Student Travel Grants** will be awarded at the conference.

**Student Participation Grant:** This grant is the difference between full and student registration (i.e. the grant for the student from outside of China is 320US\$, for student from China is 180 US\$ or 1389 RMB) and it is **ONLY** for student authors. Awarded students can register at student registration fee.

### **Student Travel Grant:**

- 400 Euros for students from outside of China
- 300 Euros for students from Taiwan, Hong Kong and Macao,
- 200 Euros for students from China mainland.

The student should submit the following material by email **in one single file (one document or a zip file with the bundle)**:

- Indicating the grant you are applying for (please **ONLY** choose one)
- Your final paper with paper ID, title, full list of authors (you **MUST** be the first author)
- Your resume
- A short statement (two or three paragraphs) indicating how you would benefit from attending **ChinaCom2007**, and a brief summary of research interests and accomplishments.
- Your advisor (or a faculty contact if you do not yet have an advisor) should submit a letter of recommendation, confirming that you are in good standing at your University, and commenting on the strengths and potential contributions of the student. Your advisor should send his recommendation letter to [info.chinacom@create-net.org](mailto:info.chinacom@create-net.org).
- It is the responsibility of the student to ensure that the advisor's email is provided.

If you are not able to attend **ChinaCom2007**, the grants will be withdrawn.
